




A chic address in the relatively undiscovered yet increasingly popular part of Montenegro.

Our Program Proposal



Day 1 Arrive Montenegro

Arrival at Tivat Airport.

A warm welcome from all Montenegro in Style team who are happy to see their guests in Montenegro and they assist them to their transport.

Transfer to our hotel at Herceg Novi by our minivan, carefully selected and pre-checked for our guests' hygiene.

Journey from the airport to the hotel takes around 50 minutes.

Check in at hotel upon arrival and deliver the welcome kit containing disinfected room keys and other materials prepared for the guests.

Enjoy the hotel for some time at leisure to relax and refresh. Depending on the time of the arrival, a full or snack lunch can be taken at hotel's terrace restaurant overlooking the beautiful views of the marina and the surrounding mountains.

Depart hotel in the late afternoon for a guided tour of Kotor Old Town.



Tour of Kotor Old Town followed by Dinner at Galion Restaurant

The UNESCO listed old city of Kotor is located in the deepest corner of Boka Bay and at the foot of steep mountains. Today, Kotor is one of Montenegro's main tourist attractions and one of the busiest cruise ports in the Mediterranean.

Apart from its picturesque narrow streets, little squares and well-preserved stone buildings, Kotor Old Town houses several churches from various periods.

Among other attractions are The Maritime Museum of Montenegro, St. Tryphon's Cathedral and Orthodox church of St. Nicolas.

Aditionally, Kotor is surrounded by fortification walls that protected the city over the centuries. These walls extend a considerable height above the old town and it is possible to climb to the top of the walls by a flight of more than 1400 steps. The spectacular views of Boka Bay pay off the climb.


Following the guided tour, some free time for further discoveries including the infamous Kotor Cats of the old town before we start walking to the restaurant for dinner.



Dinner at Galion Restaurant

Galion Restaurant is one of the top restaurants of the Kotor Bay area. Located in the Kotor Harbor, guests can enjoy the magnificent views of the surrounding mountains and Kotor Old Town.

Day 2 Montenegro

Meeting at hotel in the morning.

Lunch at hotel followed by Sailing Regatta starting at hotel's marina.

Sailing Regatta

Sail on Boka Bay after a brief sailing instructions. Each team will have different colors caps, and on each boat will be a skipper and a representative.

Maneuver of sailing boats is quite a complex process, and because of that each participant will have certain tasks and will be shifted to activities so that everyone will get an idea of sailing (sailing, stemming, trimming, navigation...)



At the end of the Sailing Regatta, we continue with the Tour of the Church of Our Lady on the Rocks and Perast Town for the rest of the afternoon.

Tour of Our Lady on the Rocks and Perast Town

Gospa od Skrpjela is an artificial islet where we see the Church of Our Lady of the Rocks. Visit the Catholic church with its significant blue dome. Its history dates back to 15th Century.

Following the visit of the church, continue to Perast by boat.

The Baroque village of Perast is where we finish our cruise this afternoon. We stroll around to discover this pretty and picturesque settlement.

This small village houses many palaces and churches. Sitting at a favourable location on Boka Bay, Perast has always been a popular place.




Dinner at Stari Mlini Restaurant

In 1700s, Stari Mlini was a family operated flour mill for the locals of the quaint medieval town of Kotor, Montenegro.

300 years later, another family preserved the mill in the form of a fairytale restaurant of remarkable charm. For 4 decades, Stari Mlini Restaurant has been offering exclusive yet casual fine dining experience of superb quality.

As its evolution continues, Stari Mlini now welcomes guests arriving by the sea with yacht and boat docking in the restaurant marina.







Day 3 Montenegro

Meeting in the morning.

Cooking Class by the Chef followed by lunch at at hotel.







Depart hotel by Jeeps for an afternoon Jeep Safari to Lovcen National Park and Njegusi Village.

Jeep Safari, Lovcen National Park and Njegusi Village Prosciutto & Cheese Tasting at Njegusi

We drive the famous Serpentine road that consists of 25 sharp turns gradually ascending from Kotor to the top of the mountain above the town. This drive offers some of the best panoramic views in the whole Mediterranean region.

We continue to Lovcen National Park to see dramatic views of the mountains, Boka Bay and the Adriatic Sea in a distance. Those who are fit to climb there are 461 steps to climb up to Njegos Mausoleum. There is an off-road section in the national park.

We start our descend to Njegusi Village. A very nice example of traditional Montenegro, it offers specialties of the region such as cheese, prosciutto and honey to taste. We stop at a traditional restaurant where we sample the local delicacies. Short stroll around the village before we finally start driving down the Serpentine.

Back at the hotel at the end of the tour.

Depart in the evening for Farewell Reception and Dinner.



Sunset Reception and Wine Tasting at Savina Winery

Castel Savina is a boutique winery owned by the Obradovic family. Located on the slopes of Mount Savina, above monastery Savina and town Herceg Novi.

Here you can taste excellent wine, delicious food and take a tour with the people who are genuinely passionate about what they do. They produce brandy Travarica and Loza. There are excellent labels Rose-Grenache, Chardonay, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon.
